Travel to Timisoara

You can reach Timisoara either by train, arriving to Timisoara North Railway Station, or by airplane to "Traian Vuia" Airport. A bus service is available from the airport to the center of town (Route Express No. 4), as well as from the train station to the center of town (Route Express No. 3). You can also take a taxi either from the railway station, or from the airport, to the center of Timisoara.

Public transportation in Timisoara

Several bus („autobus”), tram („tramvai”) and trolleybus („troilebuz”) routes connect Timisoara's main areas and tourist attractions. The public transportation system runs between 4:45am and 11:15pm. Tickets must be purchased beforehand and validated in the ticket-stamping machine upon boarding. Tickets are interchangeable for all three forms of transport with the exception of express buses.
